The European Commission Directorates-General for Regional and Urban Policy, Employment and Social Affairs, Agriculture and Rural Development, and Maritime Affairs and Fisheries, are organising their third joint transnational seminar on Community-led Local Development (CLLD).

The seminar will bring together around 150 CLLD actors from local, regional, national and EU level as well as relevant NGOs. The event will provide an opportunity for peer learning, active involvement in discussions and exchanges between Local Action Groups, CLLD networks, experts, EU programme Managing Authorities and European Commission services.

During this seminar we will focus on capitalising and learning from CLLD experiences applied in rural, urban and coastal areas, and discussing the way forward for EU supported participatory, bottom-up initiatives. As the local strategies are to be selected by the end of this year, we will also take the opportunity to introduce newcomers to the CLLD community.

Please note that as the overall number of places is limited the organisers may have to operate a selection process for applicants. Successful applicants will receive confirmation of their participation in this event no later than 20 October 2017.

The organisers are able to cover the travel and two nights' accommodation costs for a limited number of selected LAGs. Other participants will need to cover their own travel and accommodation costs.
